- 3) XXXDAT.ZIP – Database Archive (Database in three formats, Netlist, Net Length Report)
- 4) XXXDWG.ZIP – AutoCAD Fab and Assembly Database (Fabrication and Assembly Drawings in AutoCAD)
- 5) XXXLIB.ZIP – Cumulative Library for your Company (All parts created since Job #1)
